THE WHY'S and WHEREFORE'S of ICLD

The Role of 'The Word of God' in Salvation

ICLD's theme verse says it all, "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." (Romans 10:17) God chose to reveal Himself to humankind through the Bible, the Word of God. Jesus is the "Word made flesh." When people diligently seek

God, they gravitate toward the truth of Scripture. Largely, people make the decision to receive Jesus Christ as Savior through reading the Bible and hearing the Bible preached. "And God said ..." begins the third verse of the Bible. It is conceivable that some people come to know God through the testimony of God in the natural world: "... the heavens declare the glory of God." (Ps.19:1), as well as some recognizing the imprint of

God on each and every life (Ecc.3:11; Acts 17:27; etc.); however, "How can they hear without someone preaching to them?" (Romans 10:14). ICLD exists to bring glory to God in providing quality Gospel literature free-of-charge to developing countries of the English-speaking world.

What Materials Does ICLD Send Overseas?

For a comprehensive list of materials which ICLD sends overseas, please view the web site: www.icld.org. Basically, the boxes sent to pastors and ministry leaders and evangelists and Bible teachers fall into seven categories: Bibles & New Testaments, Theology topics (Who is God, person & work of Christ, Authority of Scripture, the Holy Spirit, End Man/Sin/Salvation), Times. the Church, Commentaries on Books of the Bible, Reference works (OT/NT background, Bible dictionary/handbook/atlas concordance, Bible languages, etc.), Topical studies (preaching, marriage & family, Christian counseling, etc.), Sunday School materials (youth, teens, adults), Gospel tracts & devotional literature. Those receiving ICLD materials can see these categories outlined on the ICLD Order Form available on the web site for downloading or on a copy placed in every box shipped out. Diligent ordering over time will eventuate in a fairly complete set of resources for any pastor or ministry leader. The way the Order Form is configured will hopefully provide the side benefit of enabling pastors and ministry leaders to see the topics as an overall view of the breadth of Christian

teaching, orthodoxy, and equipping.

Why Bother with BOOKS?!

Yes, electronic devices are available worldwide; nevertheless, the cost of buying gadgets, the electricity to run them, the tech support to maintain them, the reliability of securing them – these things are not necessarily a given. Plus, two other things about "books"

still surpass the electronic way to go, as far as many are concerned: 1) owning and holding a "book" still has appeal, 2) to those of us who have researched and studied a Bible text or a topic with an array of books simultaneously open on a table before us contributes to the immersion experience of Bible study in a significant way. In my opinion 'Christian books' will be in demand in developing countries for at least another 20 years (although ICLD is sending out more and more CDs and DVDs).
